## Sharks History

Park Orchards North Ringwood Parish Junior Football Club—The Sharks—was formed in 1991 as a result of a merger between Park Orchards and North Ringwood Parish Junior Football Clubs.

Park Orchards Junior Football Club had established a 22 year history, lead by President Mr J O'Brien in 1969, whilst the Park Orchards Parish Junior Football Club was established in 1984 and lead by President Father K Mogg.

Between the two clubs, and as the merged entity, there have been over 200 players who reached 100 games, 26 players have reached 150 games, and 1 player has reached the significant milestone of 200 games.

The Sharks have won 23 premierships since forming in 1991, including a league record 5 premierships in 2004.

A number of Sharks players have also successfully transitioned in the AFL/VFL and enjoyed accomplished careers.

## Sharks AusKick

The Sharks have an award winning AusKick program based at Stintons Reserve with over 150 participants.

AusKick is for all boys and girls from Prep through to Grade 6 and is a well organised development program designed for junior footballers.

AusKick runs on Saturday mornings 9.00-10.45am and provides the kids with a **fun** environment to learn.



## Sharks Youth Girls Team

2011 saw the establishment of a Youth Girls Team at the Sharks. The team comprised 21 players aged between 13 and 18. The Yarra Junior Football League is looking to expand the concept to include a Junior Girls Team in 2012 for girls aged 8 to 12, and the Sharks are currently considering any interest.

## Sharks Senior Football Club

2011 also saw the establishment of the Park Orchards Senior Football Club in the Eastern Football League. This Senior Club has been established independently of the Junior Football Club, but on the back of an identified want for a pathway for our junior players transitioning to Senior Football.

The establishment of the Senior Club was long and involved but the rewards came in the form of a Premiership, with the Under 18 taking out a flag in the Senior Clubs inaugural year.

## Sharks Home

The Shark's play in the Yarra Junior Football League with teams from Warrandyte to Bundoora to Richmond to Camberwell. Games are played on Sunday from 8:45 am to 4:00 pm.

Our home ground is Domeney Reserve in Park Orchards, but we also access Stintons Reserve in Park Orchards and Coleman Reserve in South Warrandyte to accommodate our ongoing growth.

The Sharks, together with the Manningham City Council, maintain and develop these facilities, and is the driving force behind ongoing improvements such as the installation of flood lights, scoreboards, drainage and ground surfacing.

## 2012!

In 2011 the Sharks fielded 18 teams with 400 plus players. The teams range from Tackers (Under 9) to Colts (Under 17), and included three tackers and Colts teams, two teams in each age group, other than Under 15's and the Youth Girls Team.

The Sharks offers a good family environment for all its Members and their families, and encourages the extension of participation beyond the players.

In 2012 the Sharks vision is for increased participation and the personal development of players and volunteers.

In respect to development, the Sharks have established a Personal Development Committee, the intention of which is to develop and improve our: players football and personal skills; our volunteers capabilities and accreditation; and education of our extended family was the implementation of educational evenings on topical issues such as Drugs and Alcohol, Road Safety and Social Networking.

Increased participation starts with you! We want and encourage our existing members and their families to help us by bringing along your friends and relatives, but we also ask those of you who are not a Shark, to fully consider all of this information, and come join the Sharks in 2012!
