



CLUB CAPTAIN SELECTION POLICY



Annually the Park Orchards North Ringwood Parish Junior Football Club (Sharks) Committee select a Club Captain and Vice Captain who are the representative player heads for that season. These positions are considered an honor for any player selected, whilst providing added elements of achievement to a person professional resume.

Eligibility and attributes

- Must be a registered player at the Sharks
- Must have played at least five (5) full seasons with the Sharks
- Has the respect of their peers
- Demonstrates leadership off the field

Provides encouragement to others at all times

Applications

Prior to the commencement of the season the Director of Football circulates a request for written applications nominating to the roles of Club Captain and Vice Captain.

Selection

A sub-committee of the Sharks Committee consisting of the President, Director of Football and Director of Coaching consider all written applications and conduct interviews with applicants to identify recommended candidates to the positions of Club Captain and Vice Captain.

Committee

The names of the recommended candidates are presented to the Sharks Committee for consideration, discussion and approval.

Announcement

Once approved, the Club Captain and Vice Captain receive formal written notification from the President, and are presented to the general club at the Season Launch where they are presented with a badge which identifies their role by the President of the day.

Expectations

Club Captains and Vice Captains are expected to act as the representative for all Sharks players. They may also be required to:

- Attend Committee Meetings for feedback and player input when requested.
- Prepare a Club Captains' report for the Annual Report.
- Prepare articles for the Sharks newsletter when requested.
- Participate in some Auskick sessions on Saturday mornings.
- Participate and assist in the coordination of Colts and Tackers Buddy Program.
- Assist at Club functions such as Burger Nights and Presentation Day.
- Coordinate the Colts attendance, and represent the Club at the Anzac Parade at Ringwood annually – refer Colts Entitlements and Expectations Sheet
