



## **COLTS AND YOUTH GIRLS ENTITLEMENTS AND EXPECTATION POLICY**



### Colts / Youth Girls Sharks Jacket

As a Colts or Youth Girls player the Sharks Committee promote this group as Ambassadors and to recognise this, the Club provide each player with a jacket bearing their 'nickname' and which distinguishes them from the remainder of the Club players.

#### Coordination

The coordination of the jackets purchase falls to the Team Manager/s of the Colts / Youth Girls teams in consultation with the Club Secretary and Merchandise Coordinator.

#### Nickname

Each jacket may adorn the recipient player's nickname in accordance with the adopted standard. The Committee retain the right to reject the nickname should it be deemed inappropriate or derogatory.

### Anzac Day Ceremony

It is the expectation of the Park Orchards North Ringwood Parish Junior Football Club (Sharks) Committee that ALL Colts and Youth Girls players attend and represent the club at the Anzac Day Dawn Service in Ringwood annually.

#### Coordination

Coordination of this attendance is the responsibility of the Sharks Club Captain and Vice Captains at the time.

#### Presentation

It is the responsibility of the Club Captain and Vice Captains to arrange for the purchase and laying of a wreath in Sharks colours – Red, White and Black.

#### Expenses

Cost of the wreath will be met by the Sharks Junior Football Club upon presentation of a receipt to the Sharks Club Treasurer.

Cost of a breakfast for players attending, post the service, will be considered on receipt of an application by the relevant Team Managers prior to attending the service. The expense is to be limited to \$100.

### Senior Teams Dinner

Each year the Club hosts a Senior Players Dinner for the Colts and Youth Girls. Each player is entitled to invite one parent to accompany them to this dinner.

#### Expenses

Meal costs for the players are met by the club.
