Milestone Banners

A milestone banner is a run through banner that players use to celebrate when they reach 50, 100 or 150 Sharks games played.

Your team manager will be able to let you know when you are reaching milestone game tally

There are two steps to organising the banner:

1. Book the Sharks banner which will frame your child's crepe paper insert.
2. Order or make your own crepe paper insert with your child's detail on it.

PLEASE REFER TO THE CLUB WEBSITE FOR MORE DETAILED INFORMATION. THE BELOW IS ONLY A BRIEF OVERVIEW

STEP 1: BOOK THE SHARKS BANNER

The Club has 2 banners for use by Sharks families to celebrate the milestone games 50 Games and 100 Games (some reach 150 Games)

The outside of the banner is what you book using the online booking form on the website: Sharks Junior Football Club » Run-Through Banner (sharksjfc.org.au)

This form goes to Peter Hume who manages our banner bookings and will liaise with you regarding collection and return

The inside section of the banner is designed to be filled with crepe paper and used as a run through for the players (see Step 2)



STEP 2: ORDERING OR MAKING THE BANNER INSERT

The banner insert is a crepe paper section which attaches to the banner and is designed for the players to run through. You can order the crepe paper banner insert or you can make your own.

Around the grounds

THE AFLW MAY have wrapped up, but there is plenty of local women's footy in Manningsham and Nillumbik over the next few months to keep you entertained.

In Manningsham, the ENFL Deakin Uni Women's Leagues started on April 23 and Donvale and Park Orchards are both fielding teams this season.

In the Premier Division, Pool B is Donvale. During the 14-game season, they will play each team in their pool twice, first during Rounds 1-5 and then again in 10-14.

During Rounds 6-9, they will play four of the six teams from Pool A.

In Division One, Park Orchards will play each of the six other teams twice and have two bye rounds. A tough start for Park Orchards who will not play at home until Round 4 on May 14.

Both Premier Division and Division One have finals scheduled for August 13-14 with the Grand Final to be played either August 27 or 28.

Over in Nillumbik, Eltham, Hurstbridge, and Diamond Creek have fielded teams this season in the NFNL, with Diamond Creek fielding two senior women's teams.

The season started April 7, with all teams playing grading matches during the first four rounds. After these rounds, the competition will be split into three divisions.

This means, a few one-sided results may occur, as some of the strongest teams may be paired against some of the newer, inexperienced teams. Diamond Creek 1 is 2-0 from their two grading matches with an 18-point win over Montinorency 1, and a 126-point win over Lower Plenty-Bundoora. Diamond Creek 2 has gone 0-2 to start the season with a 59-point loss to VU Western Spurs and a 29-point loss to Whittlesea.

Hurstbridge has started 1-1 with a 52-point win over Heidelberg 2 and an 11-point loss to Mernda. Eltham has started 0-2 with a 39-point loss to West Preston-Lakeside 1 and a 14-point loss to Banyule. Good luck to all the teams, starting or continuing in their season and make sure you get down and support your local team, wherever in Manningsham or Nillumbik that may be.

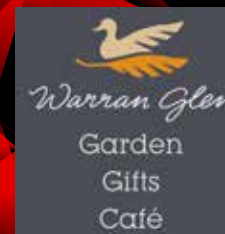
