## Food for Families Collection 18-31st July

Uniting Vic Tas Food For Families is a great way to get together to make a tangible difference to the lives of individuals and families experiencing hardship and crisis throughout the year.

The junior and senior clubs are asking families who are able to donate non-perishable and household essential items to this worthy program throughout the month of July.

By supplying food and other essential items, you can ensure vulnerable people facing crisis can access the basics they need to get through a difficult time. All food donated goes directly to people in crisis.

Last year just over 32 tonnes of food was collected, but it wasn't enough to meet the growing demand. Food relief is growing with an increase in presentation of between 30-40% in the past year.

Accepted items include:

- Pasta, rice and noodles
- Flour, polenta and couscous
- Tinned tomatoes, pasta sauces
- Beans, chickpeas and lentils
- Tinned tuna, salmon and ham
- Soups, curries and vegetables
- Baby food, nappies and formula
- Spreads - e.g. jam, Vegemite
- Long life milk and cheese
- Tea, coffee, Milo and sugar
- Stir fry sauces and soy sauce
- Coconut milk and coconut cream
- Breakfast cereal and muesli bars
- Toothpaste and toothbrushes
- Shampoo, conditioner and soap

Families are encouraged to give their donations to their TMs at training or drop them into a collection box located in the Domeney club rooms from Monday 18th July until Sunday 31st July.

# Milestone Banners

A milestone banner is a run through banner that players use to celebrate when they reach 50, 100 or 150 Sharks games played.

There are two steps to organising the banner:

1. Book the Sharks banner which will frame your child's crepe paper insert.
2. Order or make your own crepe paper insert with your child's detail on it.

## STEP 1: BOOK THE SHARKS BANNER

The Club has 2 banners for use by Sharks families to celebrate the milestone games 50 Games and 100 Games (some reach 150 Games)

The outside of the banner is what you book using the online booking form on the website: Sharks Junior Football Club » Run-Through Banner ([sharksjfc.org.au](http://sharksjfc.org.au))

This form goes to Peter Hume who manages our banner bookings and will liaise with you regarding collection and return

The inside section of the banner is designed to be filled with crepe paper and used as a run through for the players (see Step 2)



## STEP 2: ORDERING OR MAKING THE BANNER INSERT

The banner insert is a crepe paper section which attaches to the banner and is designed for the players to run through. You can order the crepe paper banner insert or you can make your own.
