## **Kokoda Track Triumph**

Many thanks to the Park Orchards Junior committee for donating five Sharks branded footballs to be shared with children in Papua New Guinea during my recent trip.

The Kokoda track was demanding and rewarding, and the Sharks footballs were happily received by kids in villages deep in the jungle between Kokoda and Kagi, as well as pencils, paints and balloons.

In Isurava, a memorial features four Australian black granite pillars that are each inscribed with a single word - 'courage','endurance', 'mateship', and 'sacrifice' - representing the values and qualities of those Australians on the Kokoda Trail during 1942. These are qualities that are important to me and the Under 16 Girls for this season.

For anyone considering walking the track, I highly recommend it, and keep your eye out for some budding AFL talent in years to come.
