

WHAT IS STRENGTH?

The ability to apply force that can be exerted by a muscle or groups of muscles in a single contraction. Strength is an important part of sport it can make a significant impact in injury prevention, better recovery and overall improvement in your game. It helps by increasing your muscle mass, overall physical strength and power.





WHAT IS STABILITY?

The ability to coordinate muscles and nervous system to maintain joint stability and balance. Improving your stability can help with keeping you balanced, strong and stable whilst you are landing from a jump, brushing off tackles and helping keep you balance whilst kicking.

5 EXERCISES TO BUILD STRENGTH AND STABILITY
