

### **Volunteer Grants Program**

The Volunteer Grants Program forms part of the Australian Government's work to support volunteers, as well as to encourage and increase participation in volunteering.

The grants provide small amounts of money that organisations and community groups can use to help their volunteers.

Through the support and assistance of our local Federal Member for Menzies, Keith Wolahan MP, the Sharks are delighted to have been successful in securing a \$5,000 Grant.

This Grant will fund the participation of 18 Club Members to complete Mental Health First Aid training with the Richmond Institute.

Around 1 in 5 Australian adults experience a common mental illness each year, however many people do not feel comfortable or prepared to offer support to someone they are concerned about.

Using an evidence-based Action Plan, the Richmond Institute's Mental Health First Aid training teaches participants the skills to recognise signs and symptoms of mental health problems, and to assist someone who might be developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis.
